Dr. Reed serves as the Medical Director for The Congregational Church of South Hempstead and the School District Physician for the Hempstead, Malverne and Roosevelt School Districts. She was recently appointed as a spring 2014 Fellow to the Office of the National Coordinator for Health IT under the Department of Health and Human Services.

Since the tender age of four, Dr. Reed knew that she would one day be a doctor and has worked to make tremendous strides for her community as an advocate for overall wellness and the prevention of chronic diseases. In 2009, Dr. Reed co-founded First Things First, Foundation for Health and Wellness, Inc., along with Sepia Owens-Villas, MPA, a not for profit that deals with health education and disease prevention.
